

Whole year

We arranged volunteers from different organizations to visit nursing homes in various regions of the country. They led festive activities, physical exercises, and other recreational activities. Throughout the year, a total of 230 volunteers participated in the program, with 14 partners collaborating, and the total number of service days amounted to 10.





25-28 Dec

Organized a return visit to patients after cataract surgery in Sulun Town, Luoding City.

15 Nov

12 doctors went to Shunde District for free medical consultation.

3-10 Nov

Charity cataract surgery was carried out in Sulun Town, Luoding City, with 19 volunteers participating. 650 people were screened and 120 underwent cataract surgery.



- 12-18 Aug We held a medical outreach program in the mountainous areas inhabited by the Qu ethnic minority, providing free basic medical services and assistance to the people in remote regions of western China.
- 18-25 Jun Forty volunteers conducted a medical outreach program at the Kechin Refugee Camp in Yunnan. They provided medical consultations to a total of 470 individuals, including the Lisu ethnic group.
- 18-19 May Fourteen volunteers visited and served at a leprosy rehabilitation village.



- 17-18 May We arranged for 56 volunteers to conduct medical outreach programs and provide services in the Sanshui and Gaoming areas. Additionally, a domestic Chinese medicine team also joined the effort.



- 3-4 May We collaborated with Shenzhen Meng'en Dental Clinic to organize a medical outreach program. Four volunteers participated, and we provided services to a total of 300 individuals.
- 29 Apr – 8 May Six volunteers participated in the relief work for the Ya'an earthquake. They raised HKD 130,000 for Ya'an and also received donations of supplies.
- 20-21 Apr Arranged for 39 volunteers to serve in factories in Dongguan.

21 Feb – 8 Mar We arranged for nine children participating in "Auditory Integration Training" to undergo individual assessments and training conducted by Dr. Jack Chan.

2 Feb We collaborated with the Hong Kong Christian Service HeartBridge Child Development Program to organize a seminar on "Auditory Integration Training," with Dr. Jack Chan as the main speaker. The seminar was attended by 35 individuals, including 24 families.



26 & 27 Jan We invited the Choir of Christian Mountain Children's Home from Kaoshiung, Taiwan to come to Hong Kong and perform at the International Christian Assembly for our two-night fundraising concert.
