

Whole year

Throughout the year, we have organized volunteers from different groups to visit nursing homes and hospitals in various regions of the country. They have led festive activities, physical activities, and recreational activities. A total of 303 volunteers from different organizations participated in the volunteer program, along with 9 partner organizations. The total number of service days amounted to 16 days.



25-27 Dec

A return visit to FoGang cataract was held, with 41 participants.





15-16 Nov

A charitable medical consultation event was held at Guangdong Leprosy Rehabilitation Village, with the participation of 20 individuals. The team consisted of 1 TCM physician, 3 dentists, 4 nurses, 1 Western doctor, 1 pharmacist, 3 medical students, and other volunteers.



15-22 Nov

Qingyuan Fogang free cataract surgery service was held. A total of 20 participated. Performing cataract surgeries for 67 people. 9 people attended the revival ceremony.

14-15 Sep

Arranged a volunteer team from Nethersole Hospital to provide free consultation services in Foshan area.



To promote the well-being of pastors, our organization, in collaboration with the Lisac International, is co-organizing a weekly Monday TCM medical consultation service for pastoral workers. Starting from September, this service provides free TCM consultations for pastors who make appointments. The co-organizing institutions include Lok Ping Medical Limited and Hengjian Health and Wellness Center. The clinic is located at Unit A, 1st Floor, Tak Fook Building, 25 Tak Road, Hong Kong.

27 Jul – 8 Aug

5 students from Guangdong Medical University were arranged to participate in the Summer Medical Outreach Service Team program. The goal of this program is to allow students to apply their medical knowledge, care for the community, and convey health information. Under the guidance of medical staff, the students will visit two factories (including the children of employees), a leprosy rehabilitation village, and a nursing home in Dongguan City to provide services.



25 Jul – 8 Aug

A group of 20 volunteers were arranged to organize a summer camp for underprivileged youth in the Sanshui area. The camp theme was "True Knowledge, Cherish." The activities included English learning, character development, and various recreational activities.





19 Jul

We assisted in organizing the "Home-based Intervention Approach" using RDI (Relationship Development Intervention) at the Xiangbo Tree Vulnerable Group Care Center in Huangzhou District, Shilong Town, Dongguan City. The event was conducted by representatives from the main organizing institution, Hong Kong Game Counseling Room Limited, who served as the main speakers.

11-12 Jul

We went to Anlitai Garment Factory in Dongguan for a medical outreach program, and a total of 25 people participated. The participants included 3 doctors from Hong Kong specializing in pediatrics, orthopedics, and dentistry, 2 nurses, 2 nursing students, 1 pastoral intern, 1 dentist from Shenzhen, 1 dental nurse, 1 urologist, 1 anesthesiologist, and 5 doctors from China.





10-11 Apr

A medical outreach service in Fugang, Qingyuan was organised, providing pediatric, ophthalmic, and dental examinations for orphans and children aged 6 to 12. A total of 23 volunteers participated, with 18 from Hong Kong and 15 from Dalingshan.



9-16 Feb

Arrange 2 staff and 3 volunteers to participate in the Northern Thailand service.

6-10 Feb

We hosted six officials from Foshan for a one-day visit to Hong Kong. The itinerary included visits to the Alice Ho Miu Ling Nethersole Hospital, the Hong Kong Baptist Hospital, and its nursing school. Afterwards, we arranged for them to visit Taiwan, including the Pingtung Christian Hospital and the University of Science and Technology.

10 January

We organized a medical outreach program in Dongguan, inviting 4 volunteers from Hong Kong and 4 volunteers from Sanshui to provide medical consultations at factories in the area. A total of 170 people received the services.
