Throughout the year, we organized volunteer services to visit hospital patients or discharged patients twice a month, with each visit lasting for three days. During the daytime, they visited the patients, while in the evenings, they engaged in arranging activities for staff to show our respect and support.

We have arranged volunteers from different organizations to provide services at nursing homes and hospitals. They host birthday parties and lead various activities aimed at enhancing the mental, physical, social, and spiritual well-being of the elderly. The activities lasted for a total of 23 days, with a participation of 12 groups and 337 volunteers.







25-27 Dec 12 people participated in the return visit after cataract surgery in Lianzhou.





9 Dec

We organized the "Journey of Grace and Fellowship" event, where 42 brothers and sisters participated in visiting domestic ministry sites to better understand the service needs. Hold the "Walk with Grace Path" event, visit domestic ministries, and learn about service needs. A total of 42 brothers and sisters participated.



24-26 Nov

A cataract restoration surgery event was held in Lianzhou, Qingyuan. Twenty-three individuals participated in the service, and a total of 86 individuals underwent cataract surgeries to restore their vision.





10-11 Sep 43 volunteers, including doctors, dentists, nurses, physiotherapists, and pharmacists, attended the Free Clinic Service Health Community Fun Day in Ko Ming District.



19-30 Jul A unique summer camp called "Unconventional Summer Vacation 2016" for the 30 children of staff members at a nursing home in the Foshan area was organized. The camp was led by instructors from both mainland China and Hong Kong, who guided the children through various activities.







6 Jul

In collaboration with the Lisac International and Tak Kee Restaurant, we organized a charitable medical consultations for Tak Kee employees every Wednesday from 3 PM to 5 PM at Tak Kee Restaurant. Each session can accommodate ten individuals. Acupuncture treatment and topical medications will be provided free of charge. If prescription medications are required, there will be a fee of \$150 for a three-day supply. The program will run for a duration of ten weeks.





15-21 May Organized a team of 8 volunteers to go to Myanmar for free medical service.





A charitable medical consultation was conducted at the Hengli Factory in Dongguan, with a total of eight participants. The team consisted of Traditional Chinese Medicine physicians, pediatricians, nurses, pediatric urologists, geriatric specialists, surgical nurses, and medical students. They provided services to over 100 employees.

8-15 Apr Arranged 20 Chinese and Hong Kong doctors, nurses and volunteers to Thailand for free consultations to serve local villagers.

25-26 Mar Organized 16 volunteers to a vocational training school in Foshan to co-organize the activity "Love in Spring Day".





21-22 Mar

We have arranged for 14 volunteers, including traditional Chinese medicine practitioners, Western doctors, nurses, and nursing students, to conduct charitable medical consultations and deliver lectures on newborn care and elderly care knowledge at a jewelry factory in Shunde.





26 Feb

We have arranged for 16 students from the Dalingshan Campus of Guangdong Medical University to participate in an exchange program in Hong Kong. They visited the Children and Adolescent Medicine Department at Princess Margaret Hospital and the Nathan Road Institute for Continuing Education in Holistic Health.

22 Jan – 1 Feb Arranged the Liugui Mountain Nursery Choir to tour all parts of Guangdong to spread love through music.
