Whole year

Throughout the year, we organized volunteer services to visit hospital patients or discharged patients twice a month, with each visit lasting for three days. During the daytime, they visited the patients, while in the evenings, they engaged in arranging activities for staff to show our respect and support.

Whole year

We have arranged volunteers from different organizations to provide services at nursing homes and hospitals. They host birthday parties and lead various activities aimed at enhancing the mental, physical, social, and spiritual well-being of the elderly. The activities lasted for a total of 23 days, with a participation of 12 groups



2 & 16 Dec

Four professionals and four doctors were arranged to talk to the staff of a hospital concerning the feasibility of the hospital offering services for special children.





11-12 Nov Arranged for 28 medical personnel to undergo training, medical exchange, and provide free medical consultations at a hospital.



15-22 Oct Ten volunteers conducted the "Warmth and Charity Cataract Restoration Campaign" at 13 nursing homes in Heyuan. They conducted screenings for approximately 2,000 elderly individuals and directly referred eligible patients to Heyuan Aier Eye Hospital for free surgeries. A total of 17 elderly individuals benefited from the surgeries.



- 16-17 Sep

  Arranged for 22 medical professional volunteers to visit hospitals in the Foshan area and conduct community health seminars on the topic of "Caring for Family Members with Illness."
- 10-11 Aug Arranged for 14 volunteers to serve at a nursing home, divided into two teams. Team A assisted with the engineering tasks, while Team B led variety programs and games for the residents.
- 24-29 Jul Nine volunteers organized a summer camp called "Run, Youngsters" for the children of staff members at a nursing home.
- May-Aug
  Organized a summer internship program to provide participants with an opportunity to learn about grassroots healthcare in mainland China and understand how Hong Kong institutions serve and collaborate with local counterparts and medical personnel.



29-30 Apr Twenty-five volunteers conducted an outreach activity called "Every Household Has Elderly: Community Charity Concert" in a village in Henan. Following the concert,

they also engaged in exchanges with local volunteers.

11-12 Mar Eleven medical volunteers conducted free consultations in Xiang Shan
