The HHO 10th anniversary cum the opening ceremony of CROSSPOINT was held at its new location at 7:30 p.m. The event included Rev Lau's 10-year review of HHO, a congratulatory video from the Pingtung Christian Hospital in Taiwan, a congratulatory video and performance by the Liugui Orphanage Choir, an introduction of CROSSPOINT by Mr. Alex Fung, an introduction of the participating organisations by Ms Lolita Ko and words of encouragement from Rev Tong Wing Man and blessings from Rev Choi Chung Ho. Rev Lau Chi-ming, Chairman of HHO, Mr. Alex Fung, Director of HHO, Dr. Leung Kam Fung, Director of HHO, Rev Tong Wing Man, Rev Choi Chung-ho, Mr. Lo Kam Wah, Adviser, Miss Susie Lum, Adviser, and Dr Lau Chun Lok, Advisor, officiated the opening of the new office and CROSSPOINT. There were 84 participants.





- 30 Nov Moved to the new site, Block B, 10th Floor, Mei Wah Industries, 1-7 Wah Sing Street, Kwai Chung
- 17 Sep The second "Blessings through food" activity was held to support underprivileged families in the Kwai Shing area. The items provided included rice, cooked dishes, vegetables, fruits, bread, and toilet paper. 19 volunteers visited 14 households to deliver these items and show their care and support.

Jul – Oct The 2md online lecture for children with autism was held , and a total of 24 people participated.

Due to a large number of letters from churches and institutions asking for donations of oxygen concentrators, an additional 1,000 units were ordered this month and sent to various places in batches. As of October, 393 units had been sent to India, 292 to Indonesia, 50 to Mongolia, 95 to Myanmar, 71 to Nepal, 30 to Palestine and 100 to Vietnam.



- 3 Jun Conducted a free clinic at China Missionary Theological Seminary, serving more than 20 teachers and students.
- 29 May An online seminar for autistic children was held, targeting parents, care givers and teachers of autistic children in China. Delivered by Ms. Elaine Chan. 10 participted.
- 21 Apr Organized the "Blessings through food " activity to show care and support to underprivileged families in the Kwai Chung area. Items provided included rice, cooked dishes, vegetables, fruits, bread, masks, and toilet paper. 39 volunteers visited 50 households, including subdivided units in Ping Lai Path, Kwong Fai Wai, and Wo Yi Hop Road, as well as elderly residents living alone in the Kwai Chung New Territories.
