

13 Jan

To support the earthquake-affected victims in Turkey and Syria who have lost their homes, a plan has been made to purchase 1,000 tents for donation to the local affected communities. The distribution will be carried out by churches in Turkey and Syria, and as of the 13th of this month, 400 tents have already been transported to the affected areas.

5-7 Jun

We arranged for 20 volunteers to serve at an elderly care home in mainland China. They conducted a lecture titled "Dealing with Lower Back Pain" and provided training for the caregiver ◦



We organized a five day intensive course on Traditional Chinese Medicine Rehabilitation Therapy, covering topics such as assessment and understanding of skeletal and muscular structures, fundamental massage techniques, meridian and acupressure massage, acupressure for common ailments, and orthopedic therapy. The course was led by Mr. Cheung . Upon completion of the course, participants can apply for the "Certified Traditional Chinese Medicine Rehabilitation Therapist" certificate issued by the National Vocational Skills Assessment Institute of the Chongqing Health Commission.



Jun to Dec

To equip missionaries with better service skills in the workplace, Mr. Ma organized a massage training program for our organization. We offered three 21-hour basic courses in May, September, and October. Additionally, an intensive 21-hour crash course was held on August 5th, and a 40-hour advanced course took place on June 2nd and July 2nd. Furthermore, we arranged for students to provide massage services to the elderly in the Shau Kei Wan area once a month from June to December 2023, allowing them to gain practical experience in massage ministry.

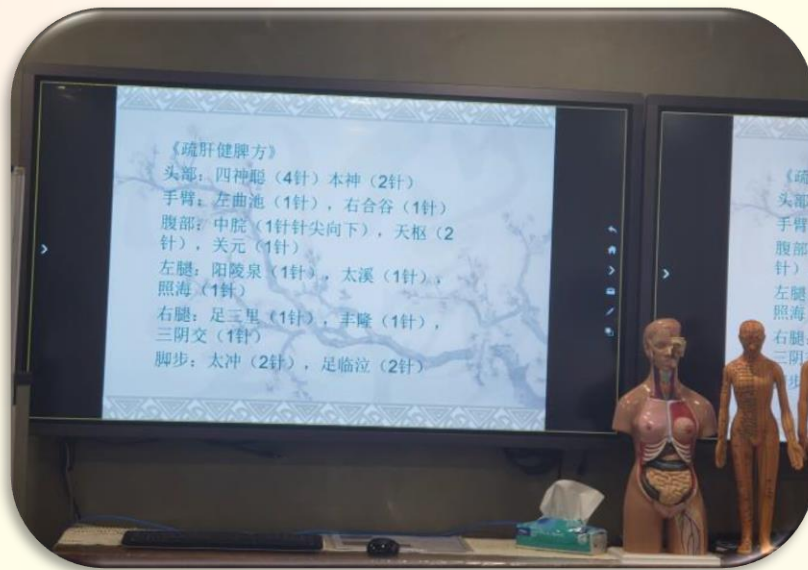


15 to 19 Aug

We arranged for 15 volunteers to travel to Guangdong Province to experience serving the elderly.

21 Aug

An intensive introductory course on Traditional Chinese Medicine Acupuncture and Moxibustion was held from August 21st to September 8th, for a total of 11 days, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM each day. The course content was rich and covered various topics including "Fundamentals of Traditional Chinese Medicine," "Emergency Treatment for Common Diseases," "Cupping Therapy," "Moxibustion", "Hand "Observation Diagnosis," The course was by Dr. Huang, and there were a total of 10 participants.



- 7 to 12 Sept We have arranged for 13 volunteers to serve in West Malaysia.
- 23 to 24 Sept We have arranged for 13 volunteers to visit local nursing homes and lead activities for the elderly.
- 10 Sept A Therapeutic Acupuncture Support Class which covers topics such as cupping therapy, moxibustion, gua sha, and electronic therapy was held. The class was taught by Dr. Tsang, and had a total of 31 participants.
